



## The Disturbing Truth About American Cause Event Speakers *Immigration and the Future of the Republican Party*

### **Peter Brimelow<sup>i</sup>**

Peter Brimelow is the owner of the anti-immigrant online journal, VDARE.com. VDARE has published several prominent white supremacists, including Jared Taylor, who after Hurricane Katrina described blacks as “incapable of sustaining” civilization. And author Kevin MacDonald argues Jews are driven by evolutionary impulses to undermine non-Jewish political control. Brimelow wrote that when one enters an Immigration and Naturalization Service waiting room, it looks just like entering the New York subways, “you find yourself in an underworld that is not just teeming but also almost entirely colored.” In Brimelow’s best selling 1996 anti-immigrant book, *Alien Nation*, Brimelow

- Writes that white Americans should demand that U.S. immigration quotas be changed to allow in mostly whites.
- Argues that spending tax dollars on anything related to multiculturalism is “subversive.”
- Calls foreign immigrants “weird aliens with dubious habits.”

### **James Pinkerton<sup>ii</sup>**

James Pinkerton is a regular contributor on Fox News and well-known author within the anti-immigrant movement. Pinkerton heaps praise on *The Camp of the Saints*, a racist French novel by Jean Raspail that has become required reading for the anti-immigrant movement.

- *Camp* describes the takeover of Europe by “swarthy hordes” of “cholera-ridden and leprous wretches.”
- “First to arrive were the monsters, the grotesque little beggars from the streets of Calcutta,” the book details. “As they groveled through the wet sand like a pack of basset hounds ... with their snorts and grunts of joy, they looked like an army of little green men from some remote planet.”
- Pinkerton writes that “while Raspail did not know the specifics of Vicente Fox’s slow-motion demographic crusade to recapture much of America for Mexico, he apprehended the general truth.”
- Pinkerton wrote that white Americans today “are lacking a proper sense of national-racial consciousness, the knowledge that one’s own is best, the triumphant joy at feeling oneself to be part of humanity’s finest.”

### **Marcus Epstein**

Marcus Epstein is the executive director of The American Cause, a conservative outfit that promotes “traditional American values,” whose chairman is MSNBC commentator Pat Buchanan, and Team America PAC, which gives money to anti-immigration candidates and is chaired by Angela “Bay” Buchanan. Epstein became well known among the anti-immigrant movement for his sarcastic and controversial writings as a student. In one piece Epstein writes:

- “Diversity can be good in moderation—if what is being brought in is desirable. Most Americans don’t mind a little ethnic food, some Asian math whizzes, or a few Mariachi dancers—as long as these trends do not overwhelm the dominant culture.”<sup>iii</sup>

### **Angela “Bay” Buchanan**

Bay Buchanan is President of The American Cause and a well-known spokesperson for the far right, appearing regularly on mainstream news outlets. Buchanan has worked hand in hand with her brother Pat (Chairman of The American Cause) and recently managed the Presidential campaign of anti-immigrant politician Tom Tancredo. Like her brother Pat, Buchanan’s extreme views on race and culture are no secret.

- She praised the presidential candidacy of former Ku Klux Klan Grand Wizard David Duke. She writes: "what really made David Duke a legitimate candidate . . . [was] the fact that he was willing to speak about issues that are controversial and difficult but that the people wanted to hear."<sup>iv</sup>
- Buchanan advocates the mass deportation of undocumented immigrants. Opposite Governor Bill Richardson on CNN, Buchanan said of mass deportation: "It is certainly not impossible. It is very realistic."<sup>v</sup>
- In a 2008 CNN interview, Buchanan defends those who lift up Barack Obama's middle name to question his heritage and challenge Obama to repudiate his middle name. Buchanan said that the question of whether Obama "has Muslim in his blood" "it is a real concern for a lot of Americans"<sup>vi</sup>
